Job Description; Site Survey Technician

The Site Technician will be site based for some 70% of their time in differing locations throughout the South, with the remaining time spent in the Maidenhead office.

The candidate will be required to install survey equipment using a series of Automatic Traffic Counting equipment, high-mast CCTV and ANPR technology for temporary roadside surveys; full training will be given.

- Daytime / evening / night shift work will be required on a regular basis and alternate weekend work will also be the norm in peak periods.
- The candidate will be responsible for the Health and Safety of themselves and those affected by the equipment used, as well as the quality assurance and checking of site works.
- The candidate will effectively resolve issues and develop technical solutions while on-site.
- The candidate will ensure timely, accurate, full and robust data collection during live surveys.
- The candidate, where necessary, will deal with the public in a sensitive and professional manner.
- The candidate will provide detailed and accurate site paperwork.
